SOIL: Clay, sandy and Limestone

AGEING POTENTIAL IN BOTTLE: Drink now or leave for 3 to 4 years

COLOR: Deeply-colored garnet

NOSE: Ripe red and black fruits with spices notes

MOUTH: Fruity and harmonious with a refined and polished tannin

SERVICE: Between 16 & 18°C.

FOOD PARING: Grilled lamb chops would seem to be the perfect partner. Or any red meat and cheese
