



CHÂTEAU JEANDEMAN CUVEE LA CHENERAIE FRONSAC



400 Years of wine making tradition. The story of Roy Trocard-family starts in 1628, when they bought their first vines in the Libourne. Since then, in every generation, there was a winemaker to keep going the tradition. Over the years, they built up a family vineyard of 68 hectares spread over 3 and 4 properties AOC Bordeaux: Château Jeandeman AOC Fronsac, Château Laborde AOC Lalande de Pomerol, Château Mancèdre AOC Pessac-Léognan, and Le Picelle AOC Bordeaux.

GRAPE VARIETY: 90% Merlot - 9% Cabernet Franc and 1% Malbec

LOCATION: Fronsac

SOIL: Clay, sandy and Limestone

WINEMAKING: Mechanical Harvest and by hand with a rigorous selection at the maximum maturity. Fermentation with indigenous yeasts to exalt the characteristics of the terroir, and a long maceration and fermentation of about five weeks in cements vats.

AGEING IN BARREL: 12 to 15 months on French oak

AGEING POTENTIAL IN BOTTLE: 10 years

COLOR: Intense ruby color

NOSE: Ripe black fruits, blackcurrant
Tabaco and chocolate

MOUTH: Powerful and complex with an excellent balance and sweet tannin.

SERVICE: Between 16 & 18°C.

FOOD PARING: Any red meat, poultry and cheese

AWARDS: Gold Medal Paris

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
