



## CHATEAU LA GALANTE ENTRE DEUX MERS

Chateau La Galante is perfectly situated on the hills of the Dordogne valley. Vines have been grown at La Galante since the 16<sup>th</sup> century. The gravel/clay, free-draining soils of the high winds that keep the grapes healthy, contributes to some of the purest wines that Bordeaux can produce. The vineyards are situated at an altitude of 110 metres above sea level in the Entre-Deux-Mers region, between the Garonne and Dordogne rivers. The vines have an average of 25 years.

**GRAPE VARIETY:** 60% Sauvignon 20% Semillon 20% Muscadelle

**LOCATION:** Entre Deux mers

**SOIL:** Clay and Limestone

**WINEMAKING:** Bordeaux traditional wine making, fermentation last for 10 days on a thermoregulated steel vats

**AGEING POTENTIAL IN BOTTLE:** drink now

**COLOR:** Lemon yellow

**NOSE:** Aromas of citrus, fresh fruity and floral.

**MOUTH:** Concentrate and crisp on the palate with notes of exotic fruits

**SERVICE:** Between 8°C and 10°C

**FOOD PARING:** Seafood & Shellfish



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
