



CHATEAU SAINT POLY

SAINT EMILION GRAND CRU

The Château Saint Poly is the second wine of Château Ferrand Saint Emilion Grand Cru Classé, a splendid cellar of 30 hectares located east of Saint-Emilion and belongs to the family of Baron Bich (pen BIC) since 1978. Today the wines from this winery are among the best in Saint-Emilion. They are produced in the purest respect for tradition with a constant search for excellence.

GRAPES : 75% Merlot 15% Cabernet Franc 10% Cabernet Sauvignon
14% vol.

LOCATION: The Vineyard is located nearby Chateau Cheval Blanc.

SOIL: Clay and Lime Stone

VINIFICATION: Fermentation with indigenous yeasts to exalt the characteristics of the terroir, and a long maceration and fermentation of about six weeks in cements vats.

AGEING IN BARREL: 18 Months

COLOR: Intense ruby color

NOSE: Ripe red fruits, blackcurrant and cherry with a touch of oak.

MOUTH: Rich and complex with an excellent balance and an elegant tannin.

SERVICE: Between 16 & 18°C.

FOOD PARING: Any red meat, poultry and cheese



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
