

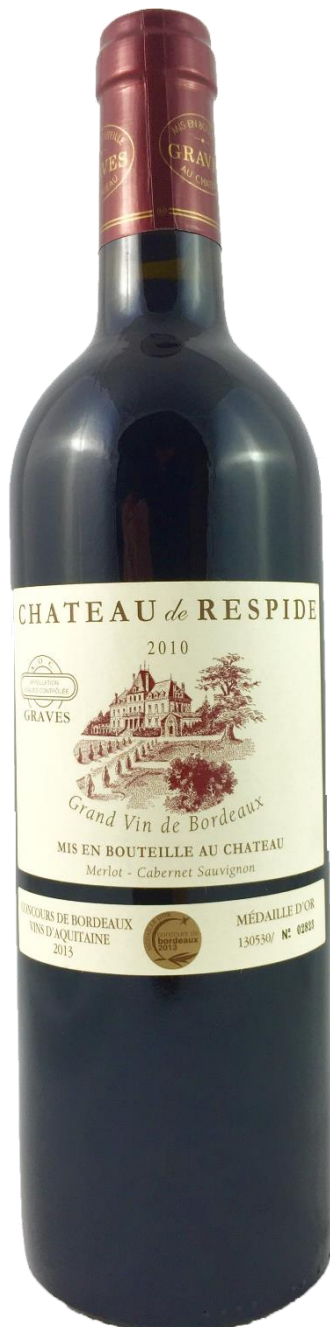


CHATEAU DE RASPIDE GRAVES RED

Château de Respide is a Graves estate located in the commune of Langon and is most renowned for the quality of its reds although its white wine is equally distinguished.

The handsome château is set in a beautiful wooded park and was once home to one of Louis XI's ministers.

The red wine is a blend of 65% Merlot and 35% Cabernet Sauvignon and is consistently smooth and elegant displaying succulent ripe black fruit with sufficient tannins and structure to enable it to develop in bottle for up to 5 years.



GRAPE VARIETY: 65% Cabernet Sauvignon 35% Merlot

LOCATION AND SOIL: Graves - Clay sandy and gravel

WINEMAKING: Traditional medocain vinification in a thermoregulated stainless steel tanks

AGEING IN BARREL: 12 in French oak barrel

AGEING POTENTIAL IN BOTTLE: 5 years

COLOR: Deep garnet

NOSE: Cedar, chocolate, blueberry and plums

MOUTH: Smooth and elegant displaying succulent ripe black fruit flavors

SERVICE: Between 16°C and 18°C

FOOD PARING: Roast and grilled meats
