



CHATEAU LAFFITTE CARCASSET SAINT ESTEPHE CRU BOURGEOIS

Chartreuse of the XVIII century, surrounded by vineyards planted in the center of the Gravelous plateau of Saint Estephe, the Château Lafitte Carcasset has been producing wine since 1790 when Sir Joseph Lafitte, attorney of the King of France, bought the domaine and created the vineyard. In 1955, the vicount Pierre de Padirac purchased the property. Since then, the vineyard has expanded and many technical improvements has been used for a good breeding of the wine.

GRAPE VARIETY: 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot

LOCATION: Saint Estephe

SOIL: Gravel

WINE MAKING: Fermentation during 20 to 30 days and the wine is aged in barrels for 14 months

AGEING POTENTIAL IN BOTTLE: 10 years

COLOR: Ruby red

NOSE: Ripe black fruits with spicy notes

MOUTH: Fruity and Harmonious with a refined polished tannin

SERVICE: Between 16 & 18°C.

FOOD PAIRING: Any red meat and Cheese
